

Galtür in summer: outdoor paradise for active holidaymakers

In summer, Galtür offers an impressive selection of outdoor activities for sports enthusiasts and those seeking relaxation. From alpine bouldering and climbing to mountain biking, hiking and trail running to cultural and nature-loving experiences, there are numerous opportunities to actively explore the region. The clear mountain air of the climatic health resort of Galtür ensures an ideal climate for relaxation.

Bouldering and climbing in the Silvapark

The Silvapark bouldering area in Galtür offers 195 bouldering routes in 14 different sectors. They consist of varied granite rock formations, ranging from moderately difficult to challenging routes. Climbers can choose between various via ferratas, including the Gorfenspitz via ferrata, which is ideal for beginners, and more demanding routes such as the Ballunspitze, which offers ideal challenges for advanced climbers. Mountain biking on the Silva Trails

The Silva Trails trail park offers a variety of routes for mountain bikers. The Alpkogel Trail runs for 6.68 kilometres from the mountain station to the valley station and offers a wide range of bends and descents. Advanced bikers can venture onto the Birkhahn Trail, which is steeper and more technical. At Siggli's Base, beginners and families will find easier trails as well as a pump track and a jumpline for jumps. The Kli Zeinis Trail, marked as a blue line, is also suitable for beginners. There is also a well-developed network of 130 kilometres of (e-)bike trails around Galtür. [More info](#)

Hiking, mountaineering and trail running

With a network of 250 kilometres of trails, Galtür is an ideal starting point for hikes of all levels of difficulty. Whether leisurely family hikes to destinations in the Jamtal valley or challenging mountain tours, such as the ascent to the Ballunspitze – hikers will find a wide range of options here. For mountaineers, there are challenging routes at alpine heights that guarantee spectacular views. The region offers special trails for runners looking for alpine challenges. From steep ascents to soft trails, there is everything to delight trail runners. The Cross Trails powered by LEKI offer ideal conditions for training with poles. [More info](#)

The mountain lakes around Galtür are peaceful retreats that invite you to relax after sporting activities. The Silvretta Reservoir and the Kops Reservoir offer idyllic places for hikes and offer breathtaking views

Silvretta High Alpine Road and Alpinarium Galtür

The Silvretta High Alpine Road is one of the most beautiful Alpine pass roads in Tyrol. The serpentine route with 34 hairpin bends leads from Partenen through the Vermunt to Galtür. Motorcyclists, mountain bikers and racing cyclists appreciate the many bends along the route. The Alpinarium Galtür is a modern museum that focuses on the history of the region and life in the high mountains. The avalanche protection wall integrated into the exhibition is particularly impressive. [More info](#)
