

Winter in Kappl: skiing, hiking and winter fun

Kappl, idyllically situated in Paznaun, offers a wide range of activities in winter. With a family-friendly ski area, opportunities for winter hiking and snowshoeing, tobogganing and an exciting Alpine Experience Programme, Kappl is the ideal destination for a varied winter holiday in the Tyrolean Alps.

Skiing in the Kappl ski area

The Kappl ski area extends over 42 kilometres of pistes with ten lifts and offers skiing fun for the whole family. With altitudes between 1,180 and 2,690 metres, snow is guaranteed throughout the winter season. The ski area is particularly family-friendly and offers a wide range of slopes for all abilities – from easy slopes for beginners to more challenging routes for advanced skiers.

The Sunny Mountain Adventure Park, an area specially designed for children where they can learn to ski in a fun way, is particularly popular. The mascot "Sunny" provides additional entertainment and various child-friendly attractions turn a day on the piste into an experience. [More info](#)

Winter and snowshoe hikes in Kappl

Kappl also offers numerous opportunities for winter hikes and snowshoe hikes. With over 20 kilometres of marked winter hiking trails, visitors can enjoy the peaceful, snow-covered landscape in a relaxed atmosphere. The trails lead through snow-covered forests and along mountain slopes, from where hikers can enjoy the impressive views of the Tyrolean Alps.

For those who want to immerse themselves in unspoilt nature, snowshoeing is the ideal activity. Guided tours through the unspoilt winter landscape offer a unique opportunity to experience nature away from the busy pistes. With snowshoes, even deep snow-covered paths can be tackled safely and comfortably, and the tours often lead to hidden viewpoints that offer unforgettable views of the winter landscape. Tobogganing in Kappl

Another highlight in Kappl is the toboggan run, which is one of the longest toboggan runs in the region with a length of six kilometres. The run is floodlit both during the day and once a week in the evening so that families can also have fun tobogganing at night. The toboggan run starts at an altitude of 1,830 metres and takes you down into the valley at breakneck speed.
